

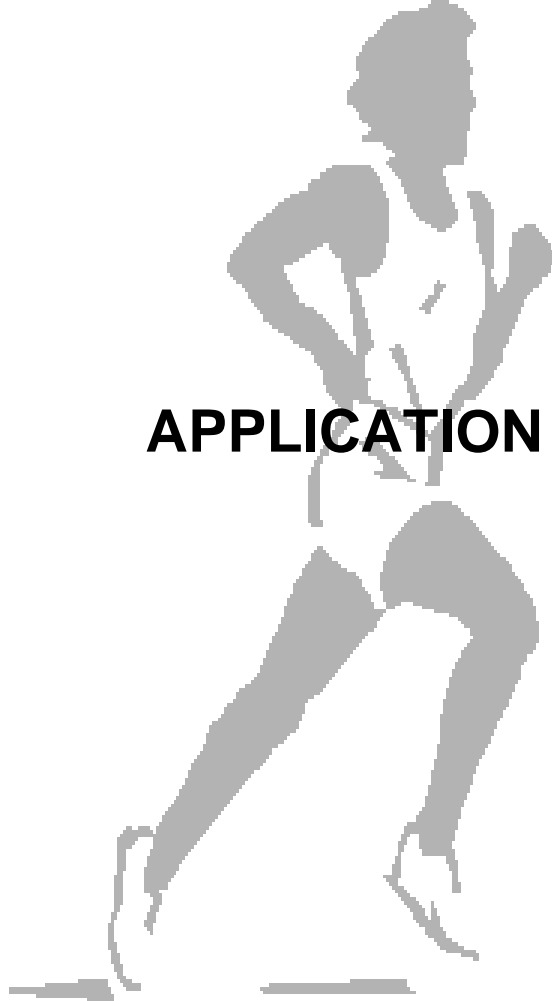

MIC MORRIS MEMORIAL SPORTING TRUST – GUIDANCE NOTES

Background

Mic Morris was a police officer and brilliant British International middle-distance runner from Pontypool who died aged just 24 years during a training run in 1983. A trust fund was set up between Gwent Police and Torfaen Borough Council to raise money for Torfaen's talented young sports people.

Eligibility

It is specifically for young people (aged from 11 up to 21 years) who reside in Torfaen involved in a range of different sports. Those eligible will be placed within four categories:

- 1 World class performer
- 2 Elite Cymru
- 3 Member of a national team or squad as specified through the list provided by Sport Wales
- 4 Ranked within the top 5 for Welsh and/or top 10 for GB (age group performance level for their discipline)

Operational Guidelines

All applications are considered at a meeting of the Trustees every three months. The following are the uses which a grant can be applied for:

- Travelling expenses
- Accommodation
- Clothing
- Equipment
- Competition costs

Application Process

An application form is to be completed in full, stating relevant details and evidence of involvement in sport at a national level, including governing body endorsement. Any competitions achieved to date or future competitions should be included and documentary evidence must be provided.

Declaration Form

All successful applicants need to complete a declaration form to inform the Trustees what the grant was used for. This form must be completed and returned before applying for another grant.
